Update of North Transept

Repair & Restoration

Stained Glass Windows

During these cold spring days, we continue to work on the St. Mary right and center sections of the Transept North Stained Glass Windows. The same process is applied, as the restoration of the St. Patrick windows in the South Transept. We safely removed these panels during February and March of 2018 and brought them to our studio in Old Lyme CT. Here they are inspected and taken apart, thoroughly cleaned, and reled "where needed". These critical areas include all of the Exterior lead and wherever there is multiple cracking and deterioration! The old lead is a type of "ribbon lead" which is very thin and malleable. Our new lead is very strong and is made up of lead containing antimony, which makes the lead stronger. We do rubbings of every window, to make sure the window goes back together, exactly as the original. We also take many close-up pictures to constantly compare and check. After leading the window, replacing and repainting the broken glass pieces, all of the lead joints are carefully soldered on both sides then grout (cement) both sides of the stained glass window. We are currently working on #5 of the 12 windows (2 columns- right and middle) Our plan is to return soon to the Cathedral and work onsite on the staging at least one day a week, removing the remainder of the glazing to remove the remaining panels in time for Kevin to insert the new protective glass on the outside. We will continue over the summer months working on the repairs and restoration at our studio. Looking ahead, reinstallation will most likely follow the same plan as last year with the South Transept, having completion for Advent season. We have all be working very hard over the past 10 years to restore the beautiful Stained Glass Windows in the Cathedral of St Patrick, so all generations can enjoy their beauty in the future. We appreciate all of your interest in our process and updates of the restoration,

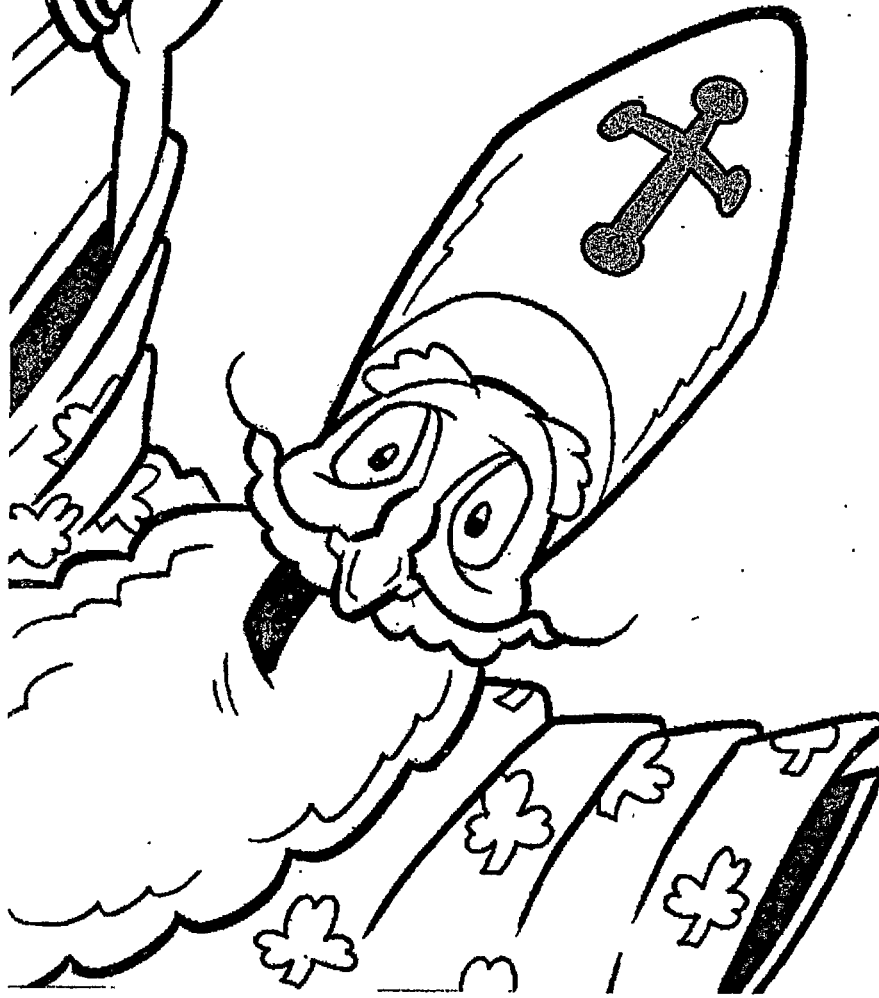
