The Collection for St. Bernard School amounted to \$2,222.00.

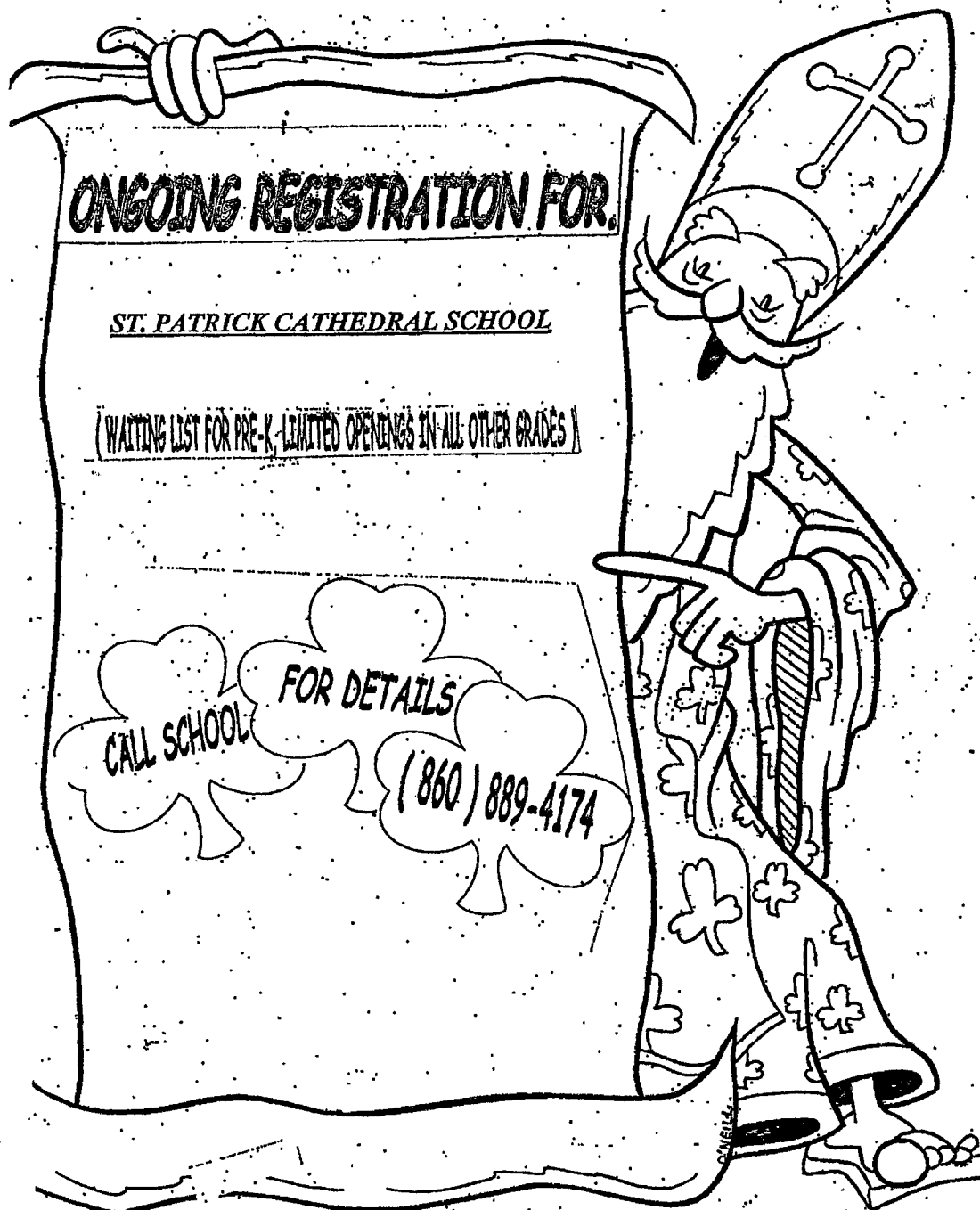
