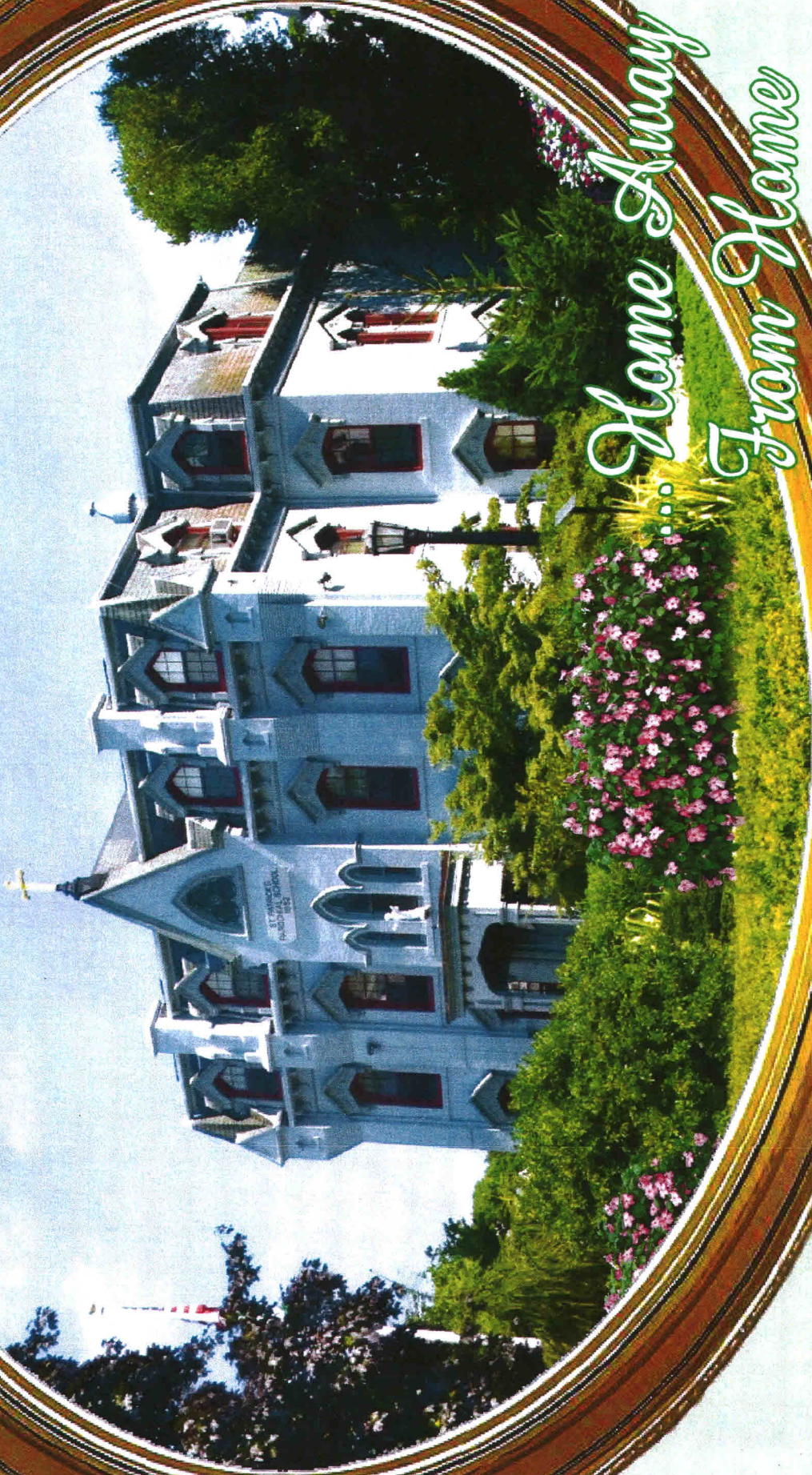

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Catechumenate is the process of welcoming new members into the Roman Catholic Church. It is meant for those who are not baptized, baptized into another Christian Church or baptized into the Catholic Church but have yet to receive the sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation. 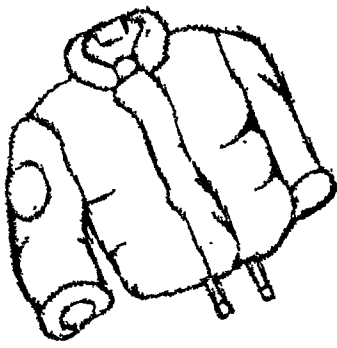

(free of rips, tears, broken zippers, missing buttons)

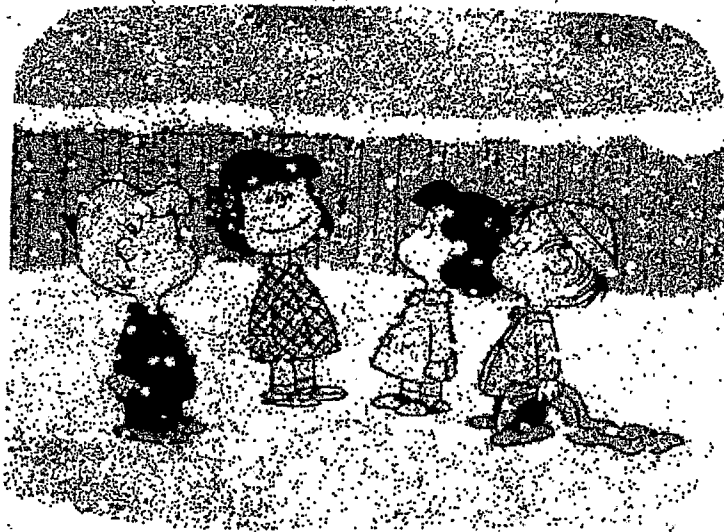
Totes for drop-off are located in every classroom and "in back of Cathedral"
